SGS #101 – Academic Research Integrity and Ethics / MANDATORY ONLINE course for all graduate students

All graduate level students must complete the course SGS 101 within the first four months (Fall Session, Term 1) after their admission to graduate studies at McMaster. This course will introduce incoming graduate students to the standards of academic integrity expected at McMaster. It will provide examples of acceptable and unacceptable practices and will clarify the responsibility and expectations of graduate students with respect to academic integrity. Students may not graduate or register for subsequent years in a graduate program at McMaster unless they have received a

passing grade in SGS #101. You must enroll in this course through Mosaic and complete the online components in Avenue to Learn in the first month of being enrolled.

SGS #201 AODA - Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act / MANDATORY ONLINE TRAINING for all graduate students

All graduate students also are required to complete training on the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA), which can be completed on-line [www.mcmaster.ca/accessibility]. Having an understanding of how we can identify and reduce attitudinal, structural, information, technological, and systemic barriers to persons with disabilities is core to McMaster University's commitment to supporting an inclusive community in which all persons are treated with dignity and equality, and completion of AODA training is critical as McMaster's graduates move forward in their varied, chosen professions.
