Versioning Policy

The Royal College versioning policy states that when a trainee is promoted to the next stage of training, they should be registered into the latest version of EPAs available for the stage they are being promoted into, and the latest version of EPAs available for any future stages. This ensures that trainees are always using the most current version of the learning path.

Changes to the EPA Dashboard

Learning Path Effective Dates

The blue bar on the EPA dashboard that displays the stage now also displays the date the trainee was promoted to the stage and the effective date of the version of EPAs that were used for that stage.

EPA added in the new version

What happens to EPAs that have been dropped in the new version?

EPAs that have been dropped from the new version will not be displayed on the EPA dashboard since they are no longer a requirement of the stage.

What happens to EPA forms previously collected on an EPA that has been dropped or fundamentally changed in the new version?

An archive has been implemented at the bottom of the EPA dashboard. It displays EPAs that have been dropped or fundamentally changed in the new version **ONLY WHEN** forms were collected on the previous version of the EPA.

For example, if EPA 1 from Stage 4 was dropped in the new version, and the trainee previously collected forms on this EPA, the forms for this EPA will drop down to the archive section. These forms can be viewed by all those who have access to the trainee's EPA dashboard.

In the example below, the trainee collected a form on AFTERHOURS COVERAGE PART B, so this form is displayed in the archive. Since no forms were previously collected on AFTERHOURS COVERAGE PART A, it is not displayed in the archive.

What happens to EPAs that have been minorly changed in the version?

No changes here. EPAs will be displayed EPA dashboard in the appropriate sequence order under the blue stage bar.

What happens to EPA forms previously collected on an EPA that has been minorly changed in the new version?

When there is a change in the milestones or breakdown of requirements for an EPA in the new version, the forms collected on the previous version will count towards the new set of requirements. The system will calculate progress on the new version of the EPA based on the forms previously collected forms. The trainee will continue collecting forms until all the new requirements are met.
